May Classes - Last Class of the series with Rich Stowell



Rich Stowell Master CFI-Aerobatic, FAA 2006 National Flight Instructor of the Year and 1994 recipient of the IAC President's Award for safety and education, is a world renowned emergency maneuver training and aerobatic instructor based at Santa Paula Airport. He is the author of several books and DVD programs on stalls, spins, aerobatics and emergency maneuvers. Rich has performed more than 31,000 spins with students from around the world -- spinning the equivalent of nearly 1,500

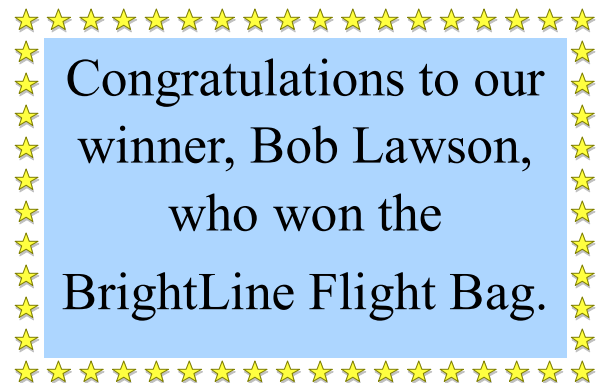
vertical miles in nearly 200 different single-engine airplanes.

Rich gave a fantastic class on stall spin awareness. He covered:

- 100 years of history regarding the stall/spin
- What you need to know to avoid stall/spin accident scenarios
- Difference between spin recovery technique and procedure
- The result of NASA spin tests & survey test pilots
- See what isn't included in your POH.
