The Air Race Classic (ARC) traces its roots to the 1929 Women's Air Derby in which Amelia Earhart and 19 other daring female pilots flew from Santa Monica, California to Cleveland, Ohio. That contest marked the beginning of women's air racing in the United States. Continuing this rich history, the Air Race Classic will begin their June 16, 2014 race in Concord, California and end in New Cumberland, PA.

This race will consist of approximately 55 teams of 2-3 women pilots each flying General Aviation airplanes "from sea to shining sea", a distance of over 2,400 statute miles in 4 days.
